She oversaw the distribution of the food that was donated to Enterprise, helped people get their yards cleared of trees and debris, appointed workers to fix houses torn apart by wind or falling trees, assigned tarping and roofing jobs to volunteers, and even led in the building of one house.

On top of all of that, she and her family have been good friends to me. She has encouraged me and cheered me on many times.

I am thankful for Kaye. I wish her well and pray her retirement is a blessing.
