A Note from Dr. Granger

Please pray for the Hispanic ministry. The new law has caused much unrest in the hispanic community. Some fear even coming out to worship. Parents are afraid to let their children out of sight, feeling that authorities may take parent or child and separate the family. Youth who have grown up in school here are afraid to go back to school. With things in play as they are, hispanics will be harder to reach and minister to.

On the ministry side of the issue, there is fear that people who support hispanic ministry will be lawbreakers. Even some of the board of directors of the SE AL Hispanic Ministry Coalition have cast doubts about their continued partnership. Without them, even the job of our Hispanic Missionary, John Gunter, will be in jeopardy. Pray for those whose lives are being thrown topsy turvy.

The facts are:

- There are nearly 40,000 hispanics in Southeast Alabama.
- There may be 3 or 4 thousand in Coffee County.
- There are over 50,000 hispanics in the United States.
- God loves these people. The church has a mandate from God to evangelize, disciple, and minister to all.
- The immigration problem is too big and too complex for a quick fix.
- The great majority of people I know do not want heavy handed methods to address the problem.

Please pray that this problem will cease to be a political football and that common sense, along with mercy and kindness, will prevail. Pray for our courts and lawmakers Pray that we all will know what to do and have the courage to act.
