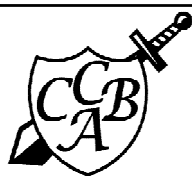

### Alabama Baptist RA Camps

#### The Vineyard Christian Retreat Center

Camp Theme: "Finding a Place to Pray" (This is a "boy's" camp. A boy does not have to be an RA to attend. The camp is sponsored by and staffed by the Alabama Baptist Royal Ambassador office.)

**4th-12th Grade Camp** June 27-30 Begins with lunch on Monday

Camp concludes with lunch on Thursday. Cost \$135.

**1st-6th Grade Lad & Dad or Mom Camp** June 30-July 02 .

Begins with supper on Thursday concludes with lunch on Sat.

Cost \$160 for two. Camp Pastor: Rev. Bill Weed

Camp Missionary: Monday-Thursday . Missionaries to Argentina & Venezuela (Two camp staffers will be college students from Uruguay and one staffer will be from Ukraine. Thursday-Saturday Missionary to China

Chaperones: Chaperones' are not necessary since we employ college age staffers to be group counselors; but if your church would be more comfortable sending someone that is fine.

Activities:

\*RA Camps feature "real boy" activities like - archery, air rifle, tomahawk throwing, blow darts, hiking, cooking on a tin can, cooking on an open fire, nature study, challenge course, canoeing , and swimming.

\*Missions are emphasized through mission classes each day. The camp missionary will be a Southern Baptist Missionaries to Argentina and Venezuela, Monday through Thursday, or a missionary to China, Thursday through Saturday. Your campers will meet three foreign student staffers, two from Uruguay and one from Ukraine.

\*Through outdoor chapel and devotions morning and evening, the camp staff provide opportunities for decisions of salvation, rededications, or commitment to church or missions vocations.
