Coffee Baptist Association hosted its annual Children's Camp July 8-10 at the Vineyard. Our Children's Committee does an outstanding job planning this camp. The members of this committee meet throughout the year to make sure IncrediCamp is successful.

We had a total of 138 campers and 80 adult volunteers leading the children. This does not include the people helping in the kitchen and with other various responsibilities. The Vineyard served an average of 250 people each meal. Without the help of volunteers from our churches, it would not be possible to serve this many people.
